# **Annual Report 2023-24**

#### **Annual Meeting:**

The 63<sup>rd</sup> Convocation and Annual Conference of NAMS, was organised from 6<sup>th</sup> October to 8<sup>th</sup> October 2023 at Ramaiah Medical College, M S R Nagar, Mathikere, Bangalore. Sixteen pre-conference workshops were held on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2023 on the current issues. The Scientific sessions held on 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> October 2023 covered the themes of Digital Technology in Communicable Disease, Military & Aviation Medicine, Industry-Academia Collaboration in Digital Health Care, Digital Integration in Health Care Profession Education, Space Age Innovative Technologies in Health Care, and Health Care Professionals as Innovators

The Convocation was organised on 7<sup>th</sup> October 2023 from 5.30 PM onwards. Hon'ble Governor of Karnataka, Shri Thawar Chand Gehlot, was the Chief Guest. # Address delivered by the President NAMS, Dr. S.K. Sarin at the 63<sup>rd</sup> Annual Convocation on 7<sup>th</sup> October, 2023 at Ramaiah Medical College, Bengaluru

The Academy was inaugurated by the Pt. Jawahar Lal Nehru, it was decorated by no less Dr. Khanolkar, Dr. K.L. Wig, Dr. S. Padmavati and Dr. J.S. Bajaj as Presidents. To walk into their shoes itself is an honour and I am lucky to have the best of the Council Members who guide and govern this Academy.

Today on this 63<sup>rd</sup> Convocation and Annual Conference I am happy to tell you that we have 1012 Fellows, 2562 Members, 75 Associate Fellows, 9661 MNAMS Members and 39 Emeritus Professors. Every year Academy recognizes and confers Fellowship & Membership, after a rigorous 3-tier selection process across all branches of medicine and allied sciences.

Sir, I want to briefly tell you about the Academy's achievements during the last year. The Academy has taken 8 major initiatives in the last year:

- 1. We started an International Fellowship & Membership to recognize Eminent Medical & Biomedical Scientists from foreign countries, NRIs, OCIs across the world.
- 2. We have started an early talent search by launching an Associate Fellowship to young DM, MCh scholars (up to 45 years of age). This is indeed an induction of young talent to NAMS Family. Please clap for those who have come this year.
- 3. The National Virtual Graduated Medical CME has been initiated with the idea to provide opportunities for postgraduate students to interact with the national eminent experts. The Navigate CME was launched on January 2023 and till date 40 sessions have already been conducted.

From September 2023, with the support of the AIIMS, we started AIIMS-NAMS Navigate Medico CME session once a month for all AIIMS on  $1^{st}$  Friday from 3:00-5:00 pm.

Now we are also initiating another online CME program in collaboration with the Association of Physicians of India.

- 4. NAMS is planning to initiate a National Leadership Development (LEAD) Program: To develop the leadership skills of the Deans, Directors, Principals, Medical superintendents, and Heads of the Departments of Medical Colleges.
- 5. NAMS also started state chapters to strengthen academic activities across India.
- 6. We also started an exchange program for medical students of various medical institutions. Till date 233 medical students have successfully completed the training program.
- 7. The Academy has been recognized by the Govt. of India as a nodal agency for promoting continuing medical education for medical and allied health sciences. Last year NAMS supported 28 CME Program.
- 8. NAMS has established 25 Task Forces for preparing policy documents on various health issues of national importance. Some of the reports have already been submitted to the government of

India, i.e., Alcohol and Substance Abuse, Organ Transplantation, Lifestyle Diseases, Artificial Intelligence in Healthcare, and many more.

April 21 is the Foundation Day of NAMS, we were privileged to have Union Minister of Defence Shri Rajnath Singh Ji who appreciated the rich heritage and contributions made by NAMS in the country. He also encouraged the defence forces to have academic linkages with NAMS. As a result, the DGAFMS Lt. Gen Daljit Singh Ji provided the necessary support for NAMS Academic activities and I see many of the army officers who have come and joined this very conference.

Now Sir, we have a vision 2030 for NAMS. Our vision is NAMS vi30 has deliberated upon by the Council last year and under this vision, NAMS would develop to act as a think tank for policymakers in all spheres of Medicine including medical education, research and cost-effective health care to help humanity at the national and international level.

Sir we need some help, we would like Hon'ble Minister Dr. Jitendra Singh Ji to help us to set up a consortium of National and International academies. You have vast experience and the authority to create a consortium.

I also have a request to Hon'ble Minister Shri Baghal Sabhab sir for convergence in various professional organizations. And you are a grassroots worker I would request you to help us to reach out with your guidance and help.

I have a message for new Fellows, please learn from each other and respect each other also and the Academy can help you, it can guide you.

#### **The Medical Scientists' Exchange Programme** (Health Manpower Development):

One of the activities promoted by the Academy under the Continuing Medical Education Programme in the area of Health Manpower Development, is the 'Exchange of Medical Scientists', who are junior and middle-level medical/bio-medical teachers.

The Academy provides funding to junior and middle-level medical/bio-medical teachers to go to well-established centers of excellence and acquire new skills. Under the scheme, the selected teachers are eligible for reimbursement of travel expenses (limited to actual II class AC two-tier rail fare) and D.A. @ Rs.600/- per diem during the training period subject to a maximum of Rs.15,000/-.

Till date (March 2024) Two hundred fourteen (214) Medical Scientists/Teachers have been selected for the advanced training. They have completed their proposed training programmes after getting the grant-in-aid from NAMS.

### **New Initiatives Taken by NAMS**

The following new Academic initiatives have been taken by NAMS:

#### 1. NAMS Leadership Development (LEAD) Program

As approved by the Council, NAMS has launched an important initiative of the Leadership Development (LEAD) Program for Directors, Deans, and Head of the Departments and senior faculty members in the AIIMS, medical colleges and institutions of national importance, to help them to become visionaries leaders and an agent of change.

The key topics covered during the workshop were leadership development, critical thinking, communication, conflicts & stress management, teamwork, time management, institution building and transformation, decision making, negotiation, advocacy, networking and collaboration, service rules, general financial rules, orientation to Government e-Marketplace (GeM) & procurement of costly hospital equipments, accounting practices, core directives of National Medical Commission (NMC), National Accreditation Board for Hospitals & Healthcare Providers (NABH) accreditation process & issues, E-library in medical institutions, role of Medical Institutions in National Health Programs /NHM, etc.

The first NAMS Leadership Development (LEAD) National Conference was organised from 8<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> March, 2024 at NAMS, Ansari Nagar, New Delhi, in which 25 participants from AIIMS and other institutions participated. This was followed by two follow-up sessions for the participants.

#### 2. Associate Membership

A new category of Associate Membership has been introduced in NAMS Family.

Eligibility Criteria for Associate Membership are Medical/ Dental Scientists who have completed Postgraduate qualifications (MD/ MS/ MDS) or MSc Biotechnology /PhD in SINGLE ATTEMPT and who also have in addition Any ONE of the following:

- (i) Membership of a National Professional organization in his/her specialty
- (ii) Scientific Publication in a Scientific Journal
- (iii) Scientific Presentation at the Annual Scientific Conference of National Professional organization

#### 3. ICMR-NAMS National Biostatistics Helpline for PG Medical Students

Both ICMR & NAMS recognize the critical role of Epidemiologists and Biostatisticians in medical research, especially for postgraduate students undertaking thesis projects. To support these students in designing and analyzing their research work, ICMR & NAMS have come together to establish a Joint "ICMR-NAMS National Biostatistics Helpline" by having a dedicated website with on-line facility, supported by highly qualified biostatisticians and epidemiologists to help medical post-graduates and young faculty members across the country to facilitate and resolve their queries related to research work.

The NAMS Council, in its meeting held on 01.06.2024 approved Joint ICMR-NAMS National Biostatistics Helpline. There have been several discussions and meetings with ICMR & NAMS Office. The ICMR has

been providing the resources for the development & operation of the Helpline. NAMS will provide support for CMEs on Biostatistics/Epidemiology for the orientation of medical college faculty, students, etc. as per its CME guidelines.

The helpline was launched on 5<sup>th</sup> September 2024.

# 4. Online certificate orientation course on AI in Healthcare for medical students and health professionals by IIITH (International Institute of Information Technology, Hyderabad) and NAMS (National Academy of Medical Sciences)

The integration of Machine Learning based Artificial Intelligence (AI) in healthcare is transforming the way of medical professionals diagnose, treat, and manage patients. However, many clinicians lack the necessary skills and understanding to effectively leverage these technologies. This course is designed to bridge this gap by equipping clinical professionals with the knowledge and tools to understand, evaluate, and apply AI in clinical settings, ultimately enhancing patient care and operational efficiency. The orientation course is designed with the objectives of providing a foundational understanding of AI and its relevance to healthcare, familiarizing participants with the applications of AI tools and technologies in clinical practice and fostering awareness of ethical and governance issues related to AI in medicine. The initial offering of the course would be targeted at 150-200 participants to assess the course's effectiveness and logistics, to make necessary improvements based on the feedback received from the initial phase and to prepare for a full-scale launch.

The Target Group is postgraduate medical students (MBBS, BDS), faculty, and medical professionals with any of the following qualifications: MD, MS, MCh, DM, MDS, and the eligibility criteria are basic understanding of healthcare processes and clinical practice and curiosity for understanding the impact of modern technology in healthcare. The duration of the course is 12 weeks. The course was launched on  $15^{\text{th}}$  September, 2024.

#### 5. MEDI-QUEST 2023: NAMS National Quiz

The National Academy of Medical Sciences conducted "MEDI-QUEST", a National Quiz for doctors and medical students, as part of the NAMS Conference 2023. The Quiz masters for MEDI-QUEST 2023 were Dr. Preethy Kathiresan, Assistant Professor of Psychiatry, AIIMS Delhi, Dr. Jaswant Jangra, Senior Resident (Psychiatry), AIIMS Delhi, Dr. Saurabh Bhatia, Ex- Senior Resident (Dermatology), AIIMS Delhi, Dr. Nikhil Mehta, Senior Resident (Dermatology), AIIMS Delhi and Dr. Akshata Rao, Senior Resident (Geriatric Medicine), AIIMS Delhi.

The Quiz focused on Current Affairs, Sports, History, Movies, Physical Health and Mental Health. There was no registration fee for the quiz and it was conducted completely online, to enable a maximum number of students and residents to join. The eligible participants in the quiz were MBBS students and medical doctors who completed MBBS within the past 10 years. Information about the quiz was disseminated through social media, whatsapp groups of medical students and residents, and also through the email list of the National Academy of Medical Sciences. A total of 308 participants from 111 medical college/institutions from 23 states and Union territories (19 states and 4 UTs) registered for the preliminary round. The preliminary round was conducted on 24<sup>th</sup> September 2023 from 7 PM to 7:40 PM online. All the participants were given an E-certificate of participation. Based on the highest scores received in the preliminary round, top 6 participants were selected for the final round.

The top 6 finalists were (1) Dr. Ajay Emani, Senior Resident (Neurology) from Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Institute of Medical Sciences, Lucknow; (2) Dr. Anoop Kumar, MBBS student from Rama Medical College, Hapur; (3) Dr. Barada Prasad, Junior Resident (Emergency Medicine) from AIIMS, New Delhi; (4) Dr. Arun Ghosh, Junior Resident (Pharmacology) from Maulana Azad Medical College, Delhi;

(5) Dr. Subhicksha, Junior Resident, Mysore Medical College and Research Institute and (6) Dr. Shubh Anand, MBBS Student from Maulana Azad Medical College, Delhi.

The final round was conducted on 8<sup>th</sup> October 2023 from 10 am to 12 PM online. There were four rounds in the final quiz – Warm up Round, What is your Poison Round, What is your Weapon Round and Matching Round. At the end of the four rounds, the top three winners were Dr. Arun Ghosh (First Rank), Dr. Ajay Emani (Second Rank) and Dr. Barada Prasad (Third Rank). The top three winners were awarded a cash prize of Rs.10,000; Rs.8,000 and Rs.5,000 respectively. All the other three runners-up were awarded cash prize of Rs.1000 each.

**6. NAMS Mini CME guidelines:** The Council has approved the conduct of Mini CME for less than 8 hours.

The procedure for Mini CME is as under:

- o As soon as the request application in format is received for conduct of CME it is sent to the technical reviewer for approval. Technical reviewer is nominated by the Secretary.
- o After the approval of the Technical reviewer is received the grant-in-aid is sanctioned and a sanctioned letter is sent to the Organizing Secretary.
- o An observer for the CME Programm is also nominated.
- o Grant-in-aid for CME will be upto Rs. 25,000

#### 7. NAMS Recognition of "Women in Medicine"

NAMS fosters and utilises the academic excellence of health professionals in the country as its resources to promote excellence in medical education and skill development in the field of medicine and allied sciences. The NAMS Council has approved to honour eminent medical & biomedical women scientists in India as NAMS "Women in Medicine" recognising their academic achievements & contributions.

For the year 2023, Dr. Prema Ramachandran, past President of NAMS, Dr. Anita Saxena, Cardiologist of international repute and Dr. M.V. Padma Srivastava, Professor, Head, Department of Neurology, Chief, Neurosciences Center, All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi, were honoured as NAMS "Women in Medicine" during the NAMS Annual Scientific Conference & Convocation held at Bangalore in 2023.

For the year 2024, three eminent women medical & biomedical Scientists were honoured as NAMS "Women in Medicine 2024" for their Academic Excellence & contributions in the Conference organised by Prof. (Dr.) Meenu Singh, Executive Director & CEO, AIIMS Rishikesh, on 10th August 2024. Dr. Pragya R. Yadav, Director-in-charge, National Institute of One Health, Nagpur played an important role during the COVID-19 pandemic, she contributed to the quick isolation of SARS-CoV-2 virus from India which was utilized by Bharat Biotech International Limited to generate the first Indigenous vaccine (COVAXIN™). Dr. Savita Malhotra, Senior Consultant at Fortis Hospital, Mohali, Ex-Dean, Prof and HOD, Psychiatry PGIMER Chandigarh, has made great contributions to research in child psychiatry, acute and transient psychosis, and telepsychiatry. She got an Indian patent for the Invention "Automated System and Method for Telepsychiatry" Dr. Sheffali Gulati, Faculty-in-charge, Centre of Excellence & Advanced Research for Childhood Neuro-developmental Disorders, Department of Pediatrics, AIIMS, New Delhi, is a trailblazing figure in the field of pediatric neurology, renowned for her extensive contributions in Autism and other neuro-developmental disorders spans across three decades.

#### 8. NAMS Research Fellowship

NAMS initiated Research Fellowship for postgraduate medical students and young faculty from Northeastern states, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Andaman & Nicobar, Daman & Diu, J&K, Ladakh.

#### 9. Networking with Medical Colleges/Institutions

Regular zoom meetings are being held with Directors, Principals, Deans, Faculty members of Medical Colleges and NAMS State Conveners under the chairmanship of the President, NAMS, in which they are invited to participate in NAMS Academic activities. 62 NAMS Cells have been established in Medical Colleges/Institutions for Joint academic activities with the National Academy of Medical Sciences. These are acting as the contact point for promoting the academic activities of NAMS.

#### **Guidelines for the Implementation of NAMS Task Forces**

The following broad guidelines are suggested for the functioning of NAMS task forces:

- 1. The NAMS Council identifies the Theme for NAMS Task Force.
- 2. The Member Secretary for the Task Force should be identified among the members of the Task Force by consensus.
- 3. The Chairperson of the Task Force will schedule & conduct the meetings of the Task Force as per the agreed date and time, on a suitable online platform.
- 4. The Task Force members under the guidance of the Chairman will discuss & identify core issues with consensus.
- 5. The relevant Technical documents, papers, reports, etc as background materials will be identified as empirical evidence during discussions & recommendations.


