



Significant Accounting policies and notes forming part of accounts for the year ended 31st March 2022

A) Significant Accounting Policies

- Accounting Convention: The financial statements have been prepared under the historical
 cost convention on cash basis except FDR Interest which is accounted on accrual basis to
 comply with the tax provisions.
- Revenue Recognition: All the revenue including grants and donations are recorded when received.
- Fixed Assets: The fixed assets are shown at original cost.
- Depreciation: Depreciation is charged on fixed assets as per rates prescribed by income Tax Rules, 1962.
- Grants: Grants are recorded in accounts as per specific direction of donor. The
 government grants received is shown as income and the balance of unspent government
 grant amounting to Rs.23,44,521/- is refunded and shown as a expense during the year
 under consideration.

B) Notes forming part of accounts:

- 6. During the year Life membership fee of Rs.66,50,000/- received. Out of which 75% life membership fee amounting to Rs.49,87,500/- has been transferred to life membership fund during the year under consideration as per the bye-laws of the association.
- 7. The corpus fund received by Academy for orations and awards has been earmarked for that particular funds as per direction of the donor.
- The academy has two buildings known as old building and new building Smt. Kamia Raheja Auditorium and J.S.B. Centre for Multi Professional Education. The Academy and National

Board of Examination (NBE) are sharing the accommodation of old building in accordance with the terms and conditions which has been approved by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India. The Academy is incurring all maintenance expenses and 50% of those expenses are recovered from NBE and accordingly reduced from the maintenance expenses.

3. Report of NAMS 62nd Foundation Day held on 21st April, 2022 at NAMS House, New Delhi

NAMS has introduced Public Oration. The Inaugural public oration was delivered by Sh. N.V Ramana, Hon'ble Chief Justice of India on "**Law and Medicine**" on 23rd August, 2022. The programme was attended by galaxy of medical professionals, academicians and eminent persons. The oration was telecasted on you tube.

In the inaugural address of NAMS public oration on 'Law and Medicine' the Chief Justice of India NV Ramana, mentioned that the practice of medicine was the bridge between science and





technology, and the human mind and body. Talking further about the prevalent system, the CJI said that he would speak about certain aspects of the medical education system in the country after his retirement.

The CJI's speech touched a very important aspect pertaining to the attacks on doctors during the COVID-19 pandemic. He said that it was during the Covid times when the doctors who were busy serving the people were threatened, abused, attacked, and shunned. Despite this also they continued working on the front lines and did their duty with utmost care and patience. He said it was very unfortunate.

He also spoke about the false cases that are being lodged against upright and hardworking doctors. They need a better, and more secure, working environment. We must foster an environment where more young people want to become doctors to serve Indian society."He added that the doctor should be given incentives to remain in India as some developments are leading to a massive brain drain of medical practitioners in India.

Talking about the importance of safeguarding the health of citizens, which he said the Constitution-makers laid great emphasis on. The CJI said that the courts have played significant role in realizing the goals and shaping the health care policies of our country. He further said that the Directive Principles have placed emphasis on the minutest details of health, nutrition, working conditions and welfare. In addition to the Directive Principles, the Constitution, in 11th and 12th schedules, places an obligation to provide safe drinking water, sanitation and adequate healthcare upon the local bodies."

He emphasised on the commercialisation of healthcare which needs to be checked. Private hospitals are being opened at an exponential rate. This is not necessarily a bad thing, but their motive should be service to society.

NAMS Council in its meeting held on 21st April 2022 decided to constitute several Task Forces to develop Policy paper to be submitted to the MoHFW, Government of India.



Guidelines for Orations and Awards

(i) NAMS ORATIONS

 NAMS Orations are invited from eminent Indian Medical, Bio-Medical and Dental scientists, medical educationists and community health specialists for recognizing their outstanding contributions in their respective fields every year. The scientists are selected for delivering the Orations under the auspices of the Academy.

All the decisions regarding selection of NAMS Orators and Awardees are taken after due deliberations by the <u>Orations & Awards Committee</u> and taking into consideration the quality and content of <u>published research</u> work and its relevance of the national, regional, and/or community health and relevance to the Topic of Award.

Additional criteria considered includes academic achievements and professional excellence as reflected by national or international recognition accorded to the nominee in the area of his/her specialization.

A special consideration is given to the Fellow of the National Academy of Medical Sciences and other National Science Academies in the country.

2. MAIN CRITERIA

General

- 2.1. High quality scientific and academic achievements
- 2.2 a) Fellowship of the Academy
 - b) Fellowship of National Science Academies
- 2.3. Professional eminence: Academic stature
- 2.4. Significant contributions in the fields of Health, Medical Care and Medical Education and/or National/international recognition for the research contributions.

Specific

- 2.5. Original contributions directly relevant to the stipulated objectives of the Oration or Award for which application has been submitted.
- 2.6. Research Publications as original contributions made by the applicant relevant to public health problems in the country or in a region in the country.
- 2.7. Sustained contribution in defining a health problem towards its etiology, and remedial measure.
- 2.8. Impact of research work which has gained national recognition and has been incorporated in national health control programmes.
- 2.9. Development of new specialties/health care facilities/departments or institutions.
- 2.10. Pioneering efforts on appropriate technology development which have gained acceptance by the scientific community/ Health policy makers.
- 2.11. For oration Citation index of **Ten** best publications relevant to Topic of Oration along with impact factor of the Journal during the year when paper was published and role of applicant in authorship as first author/joint/corresponding author.
- 2.12. Patents applied (1)/ published (3)/granted (5).

3. **OTHER CONDITIONS**

- 3.1. The Application received for each Oration will be considered for the year in which it is applied.
- 3.2. Orator conferred with NAMS Oration in previous year shall not be considered for another

- Oration for a period of another 5 years. After this period, He may be considered of an Oration for a subject entirely unrelated to the one for which he was awarded Oration.
- 3.3 Only one applicant is to be proposed for individual Oration.
- 3.4. Applicant can apply for only one Oration at a time.
- 3.5 All the endowment amount may be pooled and interest income realized from the pooled funds may be shared equally amongst all the awardees.
- 3.6. The Members of the Orations and Awards Committee and Members of the Council are not eligible to apply for the award of Orations.
- 3.7. Application Form is to be proposed by any of the Fellow/ Vice Chancellor/ Director and Principal/ Dean of the Institute.
- 3.8. A Fellow of the Academy can apply for any Oration directly without getting it forwarded by a NAMS Fellow.

4. GUIDELINES FOR THE ENDOWMENTS FOR ORATIONS & AWARDS

- 4.1 There shall be no upper limit for the number of awards, fellowships and medals installed with NAMS. However, creation of new orations would be restricted, under the discretion of NAMS Council.
- 4.2 The corpus amount to establish a new Oration and Award is Rs. 20.00 Lakh by the donor.
- 4.3 Persons or institutions desirous of creating these endowments shall apply to the NAMS secretary along with their proposal of donation for the endowment award.
- 4.4 NAMS shall intimate the intended donor as to the decision of the NAMS Council on their application. When approved the donor shall be asked to deposit the donation money in the bank account of NAMS.
- 4.5 The NAMS Council shall have powers to reject any offer of endowment if the stipulations of the donor are unacceptable according to the norms of NAMS.

5. **NAMING OF AN ENDOWMENT**

- 5.1 No endowment shall be named after persons who are unrelated to medical field.
- 5.2 An endowment shall be named after the accomplished NAMS Fellows, academic institutions, universities, geographical areas, alumni of medical institutions, and persons who have contributed for the welfare of medical science in India and around the globe.
- 5.3 The endowment shall not be named with religious, cast, racial or such identity.
- 5.4 The name of the endowment shall essentially contain "NAMS" as its component (example: NAMS K L Wig Oration, Fellowship, Award, Medal etc.).
- 5.5 Any of the past presidents of NAMS or the sitting NAMS Council members are ineligible to be the beneficiaries of any endowment award or medal or prize or fellowship of NAMS.
- 5.6 The beneficiaries would be invited to deliver the oration or make the presentation during the Annual NAMSCON/ Foundation Day/ Annual Function of respective association.
- 5.7 He/ she will be paid TA/DA by the Academy as per Govt. of India rules. The Registration fee of the conference will be exempted by the Annual NAMSCON organizers.
- 5.8 The awardee will receive a Medal and a Citation and cash prize of approximately Rs.5000/-for Oration & Award respectively.
- 5.9 The Oration and Award recipient will submit his research work for publication in the Annals of NAMS before he delivers/ receives Awards.

 - 1.6 The Award carries a Scroll, Commemorative Medal and Cash prize (approx. Rs.5000/-).
 - 1.7 Corpus amount to establish a new Award is Rs. 20 Lac.
 - 1.8 All the endowment amount may be pooled and interest income realized from the pooled funds may be shared equally amongst all the awardees.
 - 1.8 The Members of the Orations and Awards Committee and Members of the Council are not eligible to apply for the award/Oration.
 - 1.9 Application Form should be proposed by a Fellow/ Vice Chancellor/ Director/Principal/ Dean of the Institute.
 - 1.10 A Fellow of the Academy can apply for any Award directly without getting it forwarded by the Fellow
 - 1.11 Only one candidate is to be proposed for one Award by a Fellow.
 - 1.12 The Awardee would be invited to deliver the oration during the Annual NAMSCON/ Foundation day/ Annual function of a National Association.
 - 1.13 Awardee will be paid TA/DA by the Academy as per Govt. of India rules. The registration fee will be exempted by the local NAMSCON organizer/ Conference organizer.

On the basis of the maximum marks obtained by the applicants, **top 15** applicants may be awarded Emeritus Professorship of NAMS, depending upon merit only.

The duration of Emeritus Professorship of NAMS is **FIVE** years

(i) Honorarium to be paid to Emeritus Professor

The Council in its Meeting held on 12th February, 2022 vide Item No.5(ii) approved honorarium to Emeritus Professor of **Rs. 25,000/- per visit**.

It was observed that amount of Rs. 25,000/- per visit is on a higher side. The Committee deliberated on the issue and after discussion recommended that the amount of **honorarium** as Rs. 6000/- per day up to the maximum amount of Rs. 15,000/- per visit.

RESPONSIBILITIES & FACILITIES FOR NAMS EMERITUS PROFESSOR

- 1. The duration of NAMS Emeritus Professorship would be FIVE YEARS.
- 2. Emeritus Professor is expected to make 3-4 visits in a year for a duration of upto 4 weeks to Eminent centres in India to promote academics teaching and research.
- 3. NAMS Emeritus Professor will carry out the academic activities in his/ her specialty in any medical/ biomedical institution/centre in India. These academic activities will be:
 - a. Organizing Lecture/Seminars/Tutorial sessions
 - b. Imparting Skill building sessions
 - c. Organizing CMEs Programs
- 4. To act as Mentor & to develop the specialty/ laboratory services with newer technologies/ services in medical & allied sciences.
- 5. To help in analysis of data, interpretation/ writing research papers and reports.
- 6. They will **NOT** be involved in any patient care in the host institution. Though, he/she can be called for any opinion on any patient by Host institution.
- 7. Prior approval from the NAMS office for the proposed visit giving the following details:
 - a. Name, address of the Institution and Specialty/ department
 - b. Details of the proposed academic activities
 - c. The consent of the Head of host institution.
 - d. The local hospitality and logistics would be provided by the host institution. They would also be provided an office Assistance (Space, computer, internet etc.) and secretarial staff for their academic work by the host institution
- 8. They would be required to submit the Report on his/her visit to the Academy as per the NAMS format for perusal of the NAMS Council
- 9. The Honorarium for the Emeritus Professor will be Rs. 6000/- per day to a maximum of Rs. 15,000/- per visit.

iv) TRAINING OF JUNIOR AND MIDDLE LEVEL MEDICAL SCIENTISTS/TEACHERS

Guidelines, Application and Evaluation Proforma for the remuneration for The Medical/Biomedical Scientists' Exchange Programme for Training of Junior and Middle Level Medical Scientists/Teachers

- 1. Training of Junior and Middle Level Medical Scientists/Teachers under "The Medical Scientists' Exchange Programme" of the NAMS
- 2. As an extension to Continued Medical Education programme, the Academy encourages and provides sponsorship to Junior and Middle level bio-medical scientists/teachers for obtaining training in the area of their choice in well established Centre/ institutes of national eminence by providing financial assistance.
- Notification for nomination is issued every year in May/June with last date of receipt as 31st August, to all the Vice-Chancellor of Universities and Principal/ Dean of Govt. Medical Colleges in India/ Fellows/MAMS/MNAMS.
- 4. The candidate himself should select the institute of National eminence for specialized training.

Essential requirements:

- i) The nomination is made by the Head of the Institution in which applicant is working
- ii) Consent letter from the host institute in which training is to be obtained
- iii) On successful completion of training a certificate of completion of training from the host training institute is required to be submitted for claiming reimbursement.
- 5. The Academy provides financial assistance as follows:
 - i) Reimbursement of travelling expenses: 2nd class AC railway fare for onward and return journey to the institute/centre
 - ii) Daily Allowance at the rate of Rs 600/- per day (maximum up to Rs.15,000/-)
