

## ABOUT LIBRARY

• Etymology of "Library"

Derived from a Latin word "Liber" which means "Book"

In Greek word "Bibliotheca"

Definition by ALA: A collection or group of collections of books and/or other print or non print materials organized and maintained for use (reading, consultation, study, research, etc.).



A collections of electronic information resources created, managed and maintained in order to serve the information needs of a particular user population




## ADVANTAGES OF E-LIBRARY

#### COMPONENTS OF E-LIBRARY




#### HOW TO DEVELOP E-LIBRARY






#### OPEN ATHENS ACCESS

- User will receive an auto-generated account activation link where user have to set the password.

- It will take one/two days to arrange the article

- UpToDate has separate access called Anywhere Access or it is accessible through remote access portal also.
- You can register yourself within AIIMS network
- Go to Uptodate.com > Click on Register > Fill your details; Name, Department, Password > submit registration.
- You can also send a request for uptodate registration at our official email id along with a copy of your AIIMS ID card.
- Every 3 months it requires reactivation from AIIMS IP Rangel/ Library Computers


- Readers who want to avail this service should send document/article/thesis in word format along with a scan copy of AIIMS ID card.
